

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Rep. Rush Holt, D-N.J., chairman of the Select Intelligence Oversight Panel, and U.S. Rep. Pete Hoekstra, R-Mich., the top Republican on the House Intelligence Committee, today issued the following statement after President-Elect Barak Obama nominated Leon Panetta as CIA Director:
