**How to Enter:** Entry guidelines and information/release forms for the competition are sent to high school art teachers throughout the 12th Congressional District early each calendar year.

All entries must meet the following criteria:

- **Be two dimensional**
- Be no larger than 28 inches wide by 28 inches tall by 4 inches thick
- Not weigh more than 15 pounds
- Be original in concept, design, and execution and may not violate any U.S. copyright laws.
